

The Zoom sessions were conducted over the span of eight weeks, featuring live Q and A sessions on Nearpod, arts and crafts activities including how to create recyclable material, scavenger hunts for biodiversity, and applying STEM education to understand recycling.

The work created by students was showcased in a virtual museum which allows users to take a closer look at their amazing work.



St Joseph's school students explore Hawksbill turtles

Our second Green Achiever for this month is St. Joseph's School which held a research program that allowed students to study hawksbill turtles. The hawksbill nests on sandy beaches has become critically endangered primarily because of human fishing practices.

Understanding the challenges facing the species, students questioned EAD experts, Rasha Ali Al Madfai, Section Manager for Sustainable Schools, Himansu Sekhar, Head of Marine Threatened Species, and Hind Mohsen Omar AlAmeri, Assistant Scientist, on the measures taken to protect these animals and what actions they could take daily in their community.
