Now that we have the coronavirus vaccine, can we go back to normal life?

The UAE is implementing one of the largest coronavirus vaccinations drives around the world and the vaccine is widely offered at both government and private health facilities.

More than 1.6 million shots have been administered since the UAE approved use of the Sinopharm vaccine, which is about 47,000 shots a day since it has been launched! The UAE plans to vaccinate 50 per cent of its population by the end of Q1 2021. With the increase of COVID-19 cases worldwide, UAE authorities encourage the continuation of all preventive measures as schools reopen after the winter break.

Global experts expect the impact of the new vaccines to kick in significantly over summer and life to be somewhat back to normal by next winter if the strong drive for vaccinations continues worldwide.

The initiative challenges participants through 3 levels, a quiz to test knowledge of the topic, a team survey where students identify about types of plastic and finally, behavioral changes which are weighed by points for a special champion badge!

GEMS United Indian School recycles over 3000kg of paper

GEMS United Indian School (GEMS UIS) recycled over 3000 kgs of paper waste through the One Root, One Communi-tree initiative by Emirates Environmental Group (EEG) in December 2020. GEMS UIS planted trees as they hit pre-set target of recyclable items. The students routinely deposited old books, charts, and newspapers in several recycling units positioned around the school.

The school has participated in the initiative for 3 consecutive years, totaling approximately 13,070kgs since 2018, and 6460 Kgs in 2019 alone.

GEMS UIS is committed to spreading awareness and recycling to reverse climate change and protect the Earth and educating and inspiring younger generations to become green leaders of tomorrow.

One Root, One Communi-Tree was launched to involve community members and educate and instill the values of recycling amongst them. The participants are expected to submit the recyclable materials within the span of two weeks and achieve the target quantity.




