Have you ever wondered how much plastic you use? Surprisingly, the answer will be "too much". Plastic is affordable, light, and makes life easier in many ways. In fact, our production, consumption, and improper disposal of single use plastic waste have led to a global challenge concerning plastic pollution. Every year, up to 13 million tonnes of single use plastics ends up finding its way to our oceans where it endangers marine wildlife and threaten human health as well.

In line with the efforts of Environment Agency Abu Dhabi to tackle plastic pollution issue, the Sustainable Schools Initiative in collaboration with United Nations Environmental Programme (UNEP) has launched the pilot phase of Tide Turner Plastic Challenge last March among 20 schools.

This challenge aims to educate young generation of students about plastic pollution threats and impact on marine life, other water bodies and land. Also it inspires them to think

about solutions to reduce their own consumption of single-use plastics, and encourages friends, families, schools and the community to join the challenge and fight against plastic pollution and be part of an entire generation of young leaders advocating change in the world. As a result, we received 1067 submissions. Moreover, on World Habitat Day, 4th of October, SSI Officially launched the challenge for the academic year 2021-2022 for all Abu Dhabi schools, 50 coordinators and students attended.

Now Its time for all of us to play our role and take responsibility to keep our planet clean, healthy, and free of plastic pollution.


