Mangrove National Park

Have you visited Mangrove National Park?

A perfect destination for families, bird watchers, photographers, and anyone who is interested in a nature escape route.

Here are few facts about Mangrove Marine National Park!

- Did you know that the major environmental services of the mangrove include shoreline stabilization and protection from storm waves and erosion.
- More than 60 bird species are using the mangrove as a shelter, feeding, and nesting ground.
- The mangrove is a unique Blue Carbon habitat that absorb and store carbon dioxide from air and form useful biomass compounds.
- The park is a habitat for 75% population of the total mangrove forests in the UAE.
