Best Manager Waste: SILVER Aisha Bint Abi Baker School, Abu Dhabi

The Aisha Bint Abi Baker School's approach towards the waste management has been with great effort and dedication. Although their per capita per day waste generation is lesser than the ideal per capita per day consumption for a day boarding school like they worked very hard towards improving the waste management practices in their school.

The students did simple things like for instance they reused their food waste by composting and all the left over bread was used to feed fish at the eastern Corniche. The school d used to do this once a week this whole year.

They ensured that their Paper, Plastic and Metal waste was segregated and sent to a contracted company for recycling. They also worked on finding an efficient solution for their school's $\mathsf{E}-\mathsf{Waste}$. A campaign was conducted in the school and in the community within the school's vicinity to help generate awareness about $\mathsf{E}-\mathsf{Waste}$.

Their efforts had paid off and they were able to get a lot of people to send their waste for recycling. They collected in total an amount of **6150 kg** of Electronic, Metal and Paper waste from the school and from the surrounding families. They also sent **6215kg** of bottles each month for recycling.
