

Best Manager Water: BRONZE Al Montaha School, Abu Dhabi

With two years into the Sustainable Schools Initiative, the school was very committed towards working on their water audit. They followed the process carefully, ensuring that their data was collected accurately. Since their consumption levels were not exceeding the standards, a mitigation plan was not required.

The school did realize however that the bottled water used by students created a lot of waster wastage due to half empty bottles left behind by students. They started an awareness drive within the school and managed to reduce their water bottle use from **168** bottles per day to **72** Bottles per day. On a daily basis, this made a considerable difference from almost 84 litres to 36 litres.

The water left over in these bottles was then used for planting and to improve the green areas within the school. Their next project is to reuse the grey water and they plan to also install a grey water recycling mechanism during the next academic session.
