## Best Manager Water: SILVER Knoor School, Liwa

The Knoor School has also displayed great passion for their project and they too did an accurate audit with all the tasks completed. Their data was valid and accurate and since their consumptions levels were also in the healthy range, they focused on the wastage from bottled water usage.

The students replaced their 1.5 litres water bottles to 500 ml inside the school to help reduce the water wastage. They managed to bring about a reduction from **148.2 litres** to **123.5 litres** through this measure. They too used the left over water for planting and in their lab experiments.

Apart from the measures mentioned above, it is their continuous campaigning internally within the school during the entire school year which deserves special mention. They highlighted the seriousness of the water issues in UAE through a campaign that ran the whole year involving the students, teachers and non-teaching staff.

To support the campaign the teachers also integrated the concepts about water, water issues, water scarcity, desalination etc. into their lessons and in their lessons plans for the intermediate and secondary level. Thus, this structured approach towards an environmental issue like "Water as a Resource" through awareness and knowledge transfer which then led to action which brought about a tangible difference is what made the school stand out in its evaluation.
