Best Managers Air: BRONZE Al Rowad School, Abu Dhabi

The Al Rowad School has been a winner for this category last year and they managed to maintain their performance for the second time and also improve it in this category which is often referred to a challenging element in the "Green School Audit".

Following from their performance last year, where they worked hard to ensure that 71% of their school population travelled to the school by shared means of transport; this year, they maintained the same percentage and raised it to 75%. This included both teachers and students from the school. They also encouraged those living nearby, to walk to the school.

Their campaign internally in the school helped garner support and they also planted **300** Native plants inside the schools to help improve the air quality within the school premises. Planting these saplings helped bring down the level of air pollution in and around the school.

They also worked hard to integrate the topic of air such as indoor air quality, air pollution and common pollutants etc. into their Mathematics lessons. Having seen the success of the campaign internally the school then began to encourage people living in their neighbourhood community to also travel by shared means.
