## Best Managers LAND: BRONZE Al Abbas Bin Abdel Moutaleb School, Western Region

The Al Abbas Bin Abdel Moutaleb School worked very hard in increasing their school's green area. They planted a nursery in the school spanning over 100 square meters with native plant species. The school was careful to ensure that they followed healthy and organic practices to raise these plants.

To improve the soil fertility and to aid with the saplings growth, they used camel and goat droppings that were procured from nearby farms. They planted fruits and vegetables in their nursery in addition to the native plants to help their students learn and understand the process of how they get their food.

The nurseries also served as a great teaching aid for the biology students from grade 11 and 12. The students get to take their classes outside in a manner that is more "hands on".
