Best Managers Land: **GOLD** Qatr Al Nada School, Madinat Zayed

The Qatr Al Nada School is another example of a school that is championing for the cause of Sustainability. The school has been unbeatable in the Land Audit category since the pilot phase of this initiative in 2009. They have been able to maintain their sustainable practices and also discover a new innovative technique each year.

From the initial years where they increased their green area, used bird droppings as fertilizer and planted native trees, this year they further increased the school's green area by reusing the grey water from the ablution areas and drip irrigation.

They planted 60 native plants and utilized almost 400 litres of grey water each day to nurture these plants. They also have a compost pit from the school's vegetable waste and this is also used to improve the soil fertility.
